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	1. Establishment. The position of school nurse consultant
12	is established jointly within the Department of Human Services
	and the Department of Education. The Director of the Bureau of

	Special Projects and External Affairs in the Department of
16	Education shall jointly supervise the school nurse consultant.
18	2. Qualifications. The school nurse consultant must be
20	licensed as a registered professional nurse in the State and have

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	The school nurse consultant shall provide statewide nursing

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## SUMMARY

This bill establishes the position of school nurse consultant within the Department of Human Services and the Department of Education. The school nurse consultant's duties include acting as a liaison to school health provider and policy-setting groups; providing health care, nursing, policy and legal information regarding school nursing, school health programs and professional development; promoting staff development and promoting school nursing excellence and optimal health of school children.

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
