42	attending an alcohol server education course. The elimination of the course fees will reduce Other Special Revenue funds collected by the bureau from fees by \$10,125 and \$13,500 in fiscal years
44	1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, resulting in the deletion of the corresponding allocation of that revenue.

48	The loss of General Fund revenue in the amount of \$10,125 and \$13,500 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, is unchanged by this amendment.
