HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 320, L.D. 954, Bill, "An Act to Improve Alcohol Server Education Courses"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 5th indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 33 to 35 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 5 (page 1, lines 29 to 35 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. 28-A MRSA §2519, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1997, c. 373, §167, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

5. Fee. There is no fee for a bureau alcohol server education course.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 10 (page 2, lines 14 to 29 in amendment)

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment prohibits the Bureau of Liquor Enforcement within the Department of Public Safety from charging a fee for attending an alcohol server education course. The elimination of the course fees will reduce Other Special Revenue funds collected by the bureau from fees by \$10,125 and \$13,500 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, resulting in the deletion of the corresponding allocation of that revenue.

The loss of General Fund revenue in the amount of \$10,125 and \$13,500 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, is unchanged by this amendment.
