2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6724-A is enacted to read:**

6 **§6724-A. Drag limits on Medomak River**

8 It is unlawful to fish for or take scallops with any scallop
10 drag, chain sweep or rock drag in the Medomak River, from the
12 waters inside and upstream of a line drawn from the southernmost
14 tip of Jones Neck in Waldoboro northwest to the southernmost tip
16 of Hardy Island then true west to Keene Neck in Bremen, including
18 all waters of Broad Cove, Eastern Branch and Western Branch from
20 April 1st to December 31st of each year, both days inclusive.

16 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill prohibits the dragging for scallops on the Medomak
20 River from April 1st to December 31st of each year.
