COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 698, L.D. 965, Bill, "An Act to Require the State to Reimburse Licensed Vehicle Inspection Stations for Unused Inspection Stickers"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5 in the first line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Return or refund of unused stickers." and inserting in its place the following: 'Return, credit or refund of unused stickers.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5 in the 5th line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "refunded" the following: ', credited'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from the Highway Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Allocates funds to cover the administrative costs of refunding unused motor vehicle inspection stickers.
