	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1766, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
4	683, Pt. A, $\S2$ and affected by Pt. B, $\S5$, is amended to read:
6	5. Return or refund of unused stickers. Within 20 working
8	days of the end of a calendar year or the suspension, revocation
8	or termination of an inspection license, unused or expired stickers must be returned to the Chief of the State Police and
10	the purchase price refunded or exchanged for current year
20	stickers. Refunds-or-exchanges-may-only-be-made-for-full-sheets
12	of-unused-stickers.
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	SUMMARY
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	This bill allows inspection stations to receive a refund for
18	all unused inspection stickers. Current law provides that refunds or exchanges may only be made for full sheets of unused
20	stickers.
