HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 332, L.D. 986, "Resolve, Establishing a Commission to Study the Feasibility of Reestablishing a Brook Trout and Landlocked Salmon Hatchery in Northern Maine"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 6. Compensation. Resolved: That legislative members are entitled to receive the legislative per diem and reimbursement of necessary expenses for their attendance at authorized meetings of the commission. Public members not otherwise compensated by their employers or other entities whom they represent are entitled to receive reimbursement of necessary expenses and a per diem equal to the legislative per diem for their attendance at authorized meetings of the commission; and be it further'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 8 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 8. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.


FISCAL NOTE

This amendment increases the General Fund costs of the resolve by \$3,960 and \$1,760 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, from the payment of the per diem of the public members of the commission.

As amended, this resolve includes an additional General Fund appropriation of \$9,135 in fiscal year 1999-00 and \$5,120 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Legislature for the per diem and expenses of legislative and other eligible members of the Commission to Study the Needs and Opportunities Associated with the Production of Salmonid Sport Fish in Maine and to print the required report.

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the reimbursement of members of the commission to provide compensation only for Legislators and for public members not otherwise compensated by their employers.
