	Local Government Fund an additional amount of \$1,152,347 from the

28	October 1, 1999 so that it can be included in the amounts to be distributed on October 20, 1999.
30	FISCAL NOTE
32	This amendment transfers \$1,152,347 to the Local Government
34	Fund for state-municipal revenue sharing from the Maine Rainy Day Fund instead of the Sales Tax Reserve. The effect of this
	amendment on the Maine Rainy Day Fund balances and the interest
36	earnings of the General Fund can not be determined at this time.

40	This amendment substitutes a transfer from the Maine Rainy
