HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 703, L.D. 970, "Resolve, Authorizing the Knox County Commissioners to Borrow Not More than \$2,500,000 for Construction or Renovation of a District Court and Office Areas in Knox County"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph (page 2, lines 6 to 9 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "." and inserting in its place the following: '; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph (page 1, lines 22 to 28 in L.D.)'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment eliminates the provision requiring the Judicial Department to reimburse Knox County for the debt service costs, eliminating the undetermined net impact on the Judicial Department's net costs associated with the Knox County courthouse.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provision requiring the Judicial Department to reimburse Knox County.
