6	10. Driving deer. A person is guilty of driving deer if that person participates with three or more other persons in a
8	hunt for deer, during which an organized or planned effort is made to drive deer.

12	SUMMARY

This bill allows 3 hunters to hunt deer together without being guilty of driving deer.
