22	Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "4" and
24	inserting in its place the following: '-4- $\underline{12}$ '
26	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:
28	'FISCAL NOTE
30	
32	This bill may reduce General Fund revenue associated with the sale of liquor. The amount of the additional sales that would be shifted to out-of-state purchases and associated tax
34	revenue reductions can not be determined at this time.
36	This bill may reduce prosecutions for Class E crimes. If the number of jail sentences is reduced, the savings to the
38	counties are estimated to be \$82.48 per day per prisoner. The amount of any reduction of jail time and the resulting savings to
40	the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.
42	The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with
44	the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease
46	General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'
