
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 332, L.D. 986, "Resolve, Establishing a Commission to Study the Feasibility of Reestablishing a Brook Trout and Landlocked Salmon Hatchery in Northern Maine"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 47 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "the" the following: 'Speaker of the'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 2 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 47 and 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Minority Leader; one member must be from the minority party"

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the appointing authority for the 2 commission members who are members of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and eliminates the requirement that one of those members be from the minority party.
