	This bill prohibits a person from setting an elver fyke net
26	or Sheldon eel trap in the middle portion of a river, brook,
28	stream or other watercourse that can be navigated by a vessel.
20	The "middle portion" is defined as a 30-foot-wide middle section of a watercourse, as measured at high tide.
