The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will incur some minor additional costs to administer certain labeling requirements. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

12 14 This bill may increase the number of civil violations filed in the court system. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a provision to Maine's Fair Packaging and Labeling Act to specify that produce grown in another country but packed in Maine must bear a label identifying the country of origin in letters equal in size to the letters identifying the packer. The amendment also removes the requirement that produce produced in the United States must be labeled as to country of origin. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
