38	The Workers' Compensation Board will incur some additional costs to pay for interpreter services when necessary in
40	proceedings before the board. These costs can be absorbed within the board's existing budgeted resources.'

44	SUMMARY
46	This amendment directs the Workers' Compensation Board to seek advice in locating interpreters from the Department of
48	Labor, rather than requiring the board to use interpreters employed by the department. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
