COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 732, L.D. 1022, Bill, "An Act to Provide Funding for the Advisory Commission on Women Veterans"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$10,000

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$10,000 in fiscal year 1999-00 to provide one-time funding for public survey work to be conducted by the Advisory Commission on Women Veterans within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management.

No funding for this initiative is currently included in the Governor's proposed supplemental, "Part 2," budget.'

SUMMARY

This amendment reduces the General Fund appropriation to \$10,000 in fiscal year 1999-00 and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
