## An Act to Allow Crossbow Use During Archery Season by a Person who has Lost the Use of a Hand.

_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec.1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§15 is enacted to read:
6 8	15. Persons with loss of hand. The commissioner may issue an archery hunting license to a person who has permanently lost the use of one or both hands permitting that person to hunt with a crossbow.
10 12	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7102-A, sub-§6, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 24, §3 and affected §7, is amended to read:
14 16	A. It is legal, except as otherwise provided in chapters 701 to 721, to hunt any wild bird or wild animal with a hand-held bow and arrow during any open season on that bird or animal <u>and with a crossbow if the holder has been issued</u> a license pursuant to section 7076, subsection 15.
18 20	Sec. 3. 12 MRSA <sup>57406</sup> , sub- <sup>520</sup> , <sup>4</sup> B, as repealed and replaced by PL 1981, c. 414, <sup>527</sup> , is amended to read:
22	B. The following are exceptions concerning subsection 17.
24	(1) Paragraphs A, B, C, D, E and F do not apply to military organizations authorized by law to bear arms
26 28	or to the National Guard in the performance of its duty.
30	(2) Paragraphs B, D and E do not apply to firearms using the .22 caliber rim fire cartridge or to any
32	autoloading pistol having a barrel less than 8 inches in length.
34	(3) Paragraph K does not affect or restrict the legitimate possession and sale of flashlights.
36	(4) Paragraph L does not affect chapter 709,
38	subchapter IV, or any rule issued in accordance with section 7035, subsection 1.
40 42	(5) Paragraph G does not apply to a person issued a license pursuant to section 7076, subsection 15,

48	This bill allows a person who has permanently lost the use of one or both hands to use a crossbow during the archery hunting
50	season and during any open season.
