44	This bill may decrease the number of traffic infractions filed in the court system. The Judicial Department may realize						
46	some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no						
48	longer be filed. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'						

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SUMMARY

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This amendment clarifies the intent of the bill to require motor vehicle operators to stop for pedestrians in marked crosswalks and changes the title to reflect that intent. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
