24	Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§17764." in subsection 1 in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 20
26	and 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: <a href="mailto:center-right">center-right</a> except that for former Head Start employees up to 4 years of service credit may be purchased'

30	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

	'FISCAL NOTE
34	
36	Since state employee or teacher members of the Maine State Retirement System who elect to purchase certain service credits
	will be required to pay the full actuarial equivalent of those
38	retirement benefits, there will be no affect to the unfunded
40	actuarial liability of the system and no state resources will be required.'

	SUMMARY

	This amendment reduces from 4 to 2 years the amount of
46	service credit for prior service that may be purchased by former Head Start employees under the provisions of the bill. The
48	amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
