
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 749, L.D. 1039, Bill, "An Act to Allow Horse Racing Commencing at Noon on Sundays"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the first indented paragraph after the title the following:

Preamble. The Constitution of Maine, Article V, Part First, Section 8 provides that certain statutes enacted relating to confirmation procedures for gubernatorial nominees require a 2/3 vote of the members of each House present and voting.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is being presented on behalf of the Committee on Bills in the Second Reading to add the preamble necessitated by the change in confirmation procedures proposed by Committee Amendment "A."
