An Act to Amend the Androscoggin County Budget Process.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §721, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. C, \S and 10, is further amended to read:

6 **§721.** Purpose

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The purpose of this article is to establish in Androscoggin 8 County a method of appropriating money for county expenditures, 10 including the salaries for county officers, according to a budget which that must first be adopted by a budget committee and must then be approved -- by -- the -- Legislature submitted to the county 12 commissioners. This article amends the statutory method in 14 sections 2, 701 and 702 by creating a committee elected by Androscoggin County municipal officers with authority to adopt or amend the budget subject to review and revision by the county 16 commissioners and, if revised, subject to subsequent acceptance or rejection by the budget committee as provided in this 18 article. The-Legislature-continues-to-have-authority-to-approve 20 but--not--to--amond--the--budget. This article applies only to Androscoggin County.

Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §723, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, 24 Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended by amending the first indented paragraph and the first blocked paragraph to read:

 Membership. The budget committee shall consist of 9 11
 members, 3 members from each commissioner district selected as provided in this section, and 2 members are appointed from the Androscoggin County legislative delegation. The members from the Androscoggin County legislative delegation may vote on committee
 matters. The county commissioners shall serve on the committee in an advisory capacity only and may not vote on any committee
 matters.

36 In 1989, and every 3rd year thereafter, at least 90 days before the end of the fiscal year, the 9 <u>11</u> members shall-be are elected 38 by the following procedure.

- 40 Sec. 3. 30-A MRSA §723, sub-§§2 and 4, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, are further amended to read:
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Duties. The county budget committee shall review the
 budget and estimates, including the salaries for county officers,
 prepared by the county commissioners, and shall approve a final
 county budget <u>as provided in this article</u>.

48 4. Vacancies. A vacancy occurring on the budget committee shall <u>must</u> be filled by the committee for the balance of the unexpired term. The person appointed to fill the vacant office must be from the same municipality <u>or county</u> as the person 52 vacating the office.

Sec. 4. 30-A MRSA §725, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1993, c. 573, 2 §1, is further amended to read:

5. Adoption of budget. 4 After the public hearing or hearings held under subsection 4 are completed, the budget committee may-further--increase,-decrease,--alter--and--revise--the б proposed -- itemized -- budgets -- subject -- to -- the -- conditions -- and restrictions-imposed-in-subsection-3 shall adopt a final budget 8 and transmit that budget to the county commissioners. The county 10 commissioners may not revise the budget adopted by the budget committee, except by unanimous vote of the commissioners 12 elected. If the adopted budget is changed by the county commissioners, the budget committee may reject that change by a 14 2/3 vote of its membership. Those actions are final and are not subject to further action by either county commissioners or the 16 budget committee. The proposed-itemised budget and the capital improvement program submitted under subsection 1 must be finally adopted by a majority vote of the budget committee at a duly 18 called meeting held before the end of the county's fiscal year. 20

Sec. 6. 30-A MRSA §725, sub-§7, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended to read:

Assessment of taxes. The budget as approved by--the
 Legislature under this article is the final authorization for the assessment of county taxes. The budget shall must be sent to the
 county commissioners and the county tax authorized shall--be apportioned and collected in accordance with section 706.

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Sec. 7. 30-A MRSA §725, sub-§9, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 573, 34 §2, is amended to read:

36 9. Surplus funds. In developing the proposed itemized budget under this section, the budget-committee-and-the county
38 commissioners shall use 10% of any unencumbered surplus funds in excess of estimates from the previous fiscal year as reported in
40 the audited financial report for that year to reduce the tax levy for the next year. The remaining unencumbered surplus funds may
42 only be allocated for the following purposes:

44 A. To further reduce the tax levy;

46 B. To establish a capital reserve account under section 921 to fund items in the capital improvement program approved
48 under subsection 5;

50 C. To restore the contingent account as provided in section 922, subsection 2; or

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D. To fund the county charter commission as provided in section 1322, subsection 4.

Sec. 8. 30-A MRSA §726, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. C, \S 8 and 10, is further amended to read:

§726. Budget amendments

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The approved budget shall-gevern governs the expenditures of the county during the fiscal year. No expenses may be incurred 10 in excess of those shown in the approved budget, but the county commissioners may transfer funds as provided in section 922, and 12 the budget may be from time to time revised by the preparation 14 and submission of a proposed amended budget by the county commissioners to the budget committee. The budget committee shall within 15 calendar days approve, disapprove or amend this 16 revised budget. If-the-proposed-revised-budget-is-approved-of amended, - the -budget - committee -within - this - came - time - period - shall 18 forward--the---revised--budget---to---the--Legislature---for--final approval. ---The -Legislature-has-15-calendar-days-te-approve-er 20 disapprove--the-revised-budget----If-the--Legislature--is-not--in session-or-does-not-approve-the-revised-budget-within-this-time, 22 it--is-disapproved. A report of approval of a revised budget shall must be transmitted to the State Auditor within 15 days of 24 the Legislature's approval of-a-revised-budget.

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SUMMARY

30 This **bill** amends the budget approval process for Androscoggin County by removing the requirement that the budget be submitted to the Legislature for final approval. 32 Instead, the existing budget committee is empowered to adopt the budget, which 34 it must submit to the county commissioners. The county commissioners may alter the budget committee's budget only by a unanimous vote; and, if the commissioners do so, the budget 36 committee may reject the county commissioners' change by a 2/3 38 The bill also increases the number of members on the vote. committee from 9 to 11 members. The 2 additional members must be 40 Androscoggin County legislative delegation members.
