20	Act Requiring Doctors Giving 2nd Opinions in Workers' Compensation Cases to be Certified"

	Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph by
24	striking out all of the 3rd sentence (page 1, lines 16 to 18 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: ' <u>In addition</u> ,
26	the physician or surgeon must have an active practice of treating patients or must have discontinued an active practice within 2
28	years of the examination. For purposes of this paragraph, an "active practice" may be demonstrated by having treating
30	privileges at a hospital.'
32	SUMMARY
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36	This amendment allows a physician or surgeon to continue to perform examinations for up to 2 years after discontinuing an active practice.
