COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 351, L.D. 1055, Bill, "An Act to Bring Certain Maine Drug Test Levels into Conformity With Federal Standards"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph G in subparagraph (1) in the first 4 lines (page 1, lines 10 to 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "screening tests for marijuana may not be lower than 50 nanograms of delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid per milliliter for urine samples and for"

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the screening test cutoff level for drug testing for marijuana set in the bill. The cutoff level for screening tests will continue to be set by rule adopted by the Department of Human Services. The amendment retains the reduction in the cutoff level for confirmation tests set in the bill.
