SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 373, L.D. 1074, Bill, "An Act to Change the Percent of Gross Sales of Tri-State Lotto That May Be Paid Out As Prizes"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:


FISCAL NOTE

This bill authorizes a higher percentage of Tri-state Lotto proceeds to be paid out in prizes with the intent of increasing sales and participation and, consequently, increasing net transfers to the General Fund. The impact on sales and General Fund revenue is contingent upon passage of similar legislation by both of the other 2 Tri-state Lotto participants. If this bill becomes effective, the increase of sales and General Fund revenue can not be estimated at this time.'

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
