SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 377, L.D. 1078, Bill, "An Act to Extend Term Limits for Elected Officials and Constitutional Officers"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "**§553.**" by striking out all of the last indented paragraph (page 1, lines 30 and 31 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

~~'This section applies to terms of office that begin on or after December 3, 1996.'~~


Further amend the bill in section 2 in the question in the last line (page 1, line 45 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "officers" the following: 'not holding that office on July 1, 1999'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

**'Sec. 3. Application.** That section of this Act that amends the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A, section 553 does not apply to elected officials and constitutional officers in office on July 1, 1999.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment prevents those elected officials and constitutional officers that are in office on July 1, 1999 from benefiting from the extension of term limits and changes the referendum question to reflect this limitation.
