'FISCAL NOTE

This bill may increase the number of civil suits filed in the court system. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional filing fees may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a provision allowing a state court to 44 refuse recognition of a foreign judgment if there is not reciprocity, i.e., if the foreign court would refuse recognition 46 of a judgment from the state court. It also adds language regarding uniform interpretation of the law and makes technical 48 changes to correspond with the uniform law.
