2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §12709, sub-§17** is enacted to read:

6 17. Academic honors. To instruct the presidents of the
8 colleges within the Maine Technical College System to develop
10 policies whereby part-time students may be considered for dean's
12 list and other academic honors in the same manner as are
14 full-time students at those colleges.

12 SUMMARY

14 The purpose of this bill is to require that part-time
16 students enrolled at each college within the Maine Technical
College System receive the same consideration for dean's list and
other academic honors as full-time students at these colleges.
