28	'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2382, sub-§10, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
30	10. Taxes paid. A permit for a mobile home may not be granted unless the applicant provides reasonable assurance that
32	all property taxes, sewage disposal charges and drain and sewer assessments applicable to the mobile home, including those for
34	the current tax year, have been paid or that the mobile home is exempt from those taxes. A municipality may waive the
36	requirement that those taxes be paid before the issuance of a permit if the mobile home is to be moved from one location in the
38	municipality to another location in the same municipality for purposes not related to the sale of the mobile home.'

42	SUMMARY
44	This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment allows a municipality to waive the requirement that local taxes on a
46	mobile home be paid prior to obtaining an overlimit movement
