Resolved: That by November 1, 1999 the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services shall adopt rules regarding contracting for mental health services. The rules must provide that the competitive bid process is required for contractors with the department only if the contractor that holds the contract is determined by the commissioner to have performed in a fiscally irresponsible or negligent manner or has lost the required license. Rules adopted pursuant to this resolve are routine technical rules as defined by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.
