	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1812-C, sub-§8 is enacted to read:
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	8. Ratios: nursing staff to patients. The department shall
6	establish the following specific ratios of direct-care nursing
	staff to patients in nursing homes:
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	A. Day shift: one direct-care nursing staff member for
10	every 6 patients:
12	B. Evening shift: one direct-care nursing staff member for
	every 10 patients; and
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	C. Night shift: one direct-care nursing staff member for
16	every 15 patients.
18	An employer may not count a licensed staff member, such as a
	licensed practical nurse or a registered nurse, in the ratio of
20	direct-care nursing staff to patients unless that licensed staff
	member has a direct-care assignment.

26	This bill requires the Department of Human Services to
	establish specific ratios of direct-care nursing staff to
28	patients in nursing homes.
