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FISCAL NOTE

Under current law, the Salmon Aquaculture Monitoring, 6 Research and Development Fund within the Department of Marine Resources is scheduled to be repealed on July 1,1999. This 8 amendment would authorize the continuance of fund the indefinitely. No additional allocations are necessary as a 10 result of the repeal of the repeal date. Public Law 1999, chapter 16, the "Part 1" budget, includes allocations of Other 12 Special Revenue funds of \$271,788 and \$280,968 for fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, for the Salmon Aquaculture 14 Monitoring, Research and Development Fund.

SUMMARY

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency 20 clause and repeals the repeal date for the Salmon Aquaculture Monitoring, Research and Development Fund and the Maine Salmon 22 Aquaculture Advisory Council.
