COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 794, L.D. 1117, Bill, "An Act to Repeal Bedding, Upholstered Furniture and Stuffed Toys Laws"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards, will realize future General Fund savings, estimated to be \$3,500 annually beginning in fiscal year 2001-02, since the need to process certain applications and pay for product testing will be eliminated.

The elimination of licensing and application fees collected by the Department of Labor will reduce General Fund revenue by \$80,500 annually beginning in fiscal year 2001-02.'
