COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 802, L.D. 1125, Bill, "An Act to Modify the State's Safe Drinking Water Laws"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~S2615-A.~~" in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting before the following: "regulated" the following: 'detected'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~S2615-A.~~" in subsection 1 in the 7th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting before the following: "unregulated" the following: 'detected'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to adopt rules. These costs can be absorbed by the department utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the consumer confidence report covers levels of detected regulated contaminants and detected unregulated contaminants for which monitoring is required. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
