COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 806, L.D. 1129

These costs can be absorbed within the existing budgeted 2 resources of each department. The additional costs associated with submitting the required report can be absorbed by the 4 Department of Human Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.

The Department of Human Services does not currently budget 8 funds for the Maine HIV Advisory Committee nor has the department received any requests from members for reimbursement of meeting 10 expenses. Therefore, the reduction in the number of members is not expected to have any impact on the costs associated with this 12 committee.'

SUMMARY

The amendment strikes from the bill the provisions for 18 paying per diem for certain members of the commission. It also strikes a provision authorizing the commission to accept gifts, 20 grants and other funding, since current law already authorizes the commission to vote to accept gifts, grants and other 22 funding. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
