COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 810, L.D. 1133, Bill, "An Act to Reward Academic Excellence for Students Who are 16 and 17 Years of Age"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds for the costs associated with revising the Regulation of Employment poster.'

This bill will require the revision of the Regulation of Employment poster by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards. This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$12,134 in fiscal year 1999-00 for the Department of Labor for printing and mailing costs. If other bills are enacted that also require changes to the poster, the cost properly allocated to this bill can be reduced.'
