SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 811, L.D. 1134, Bill, "An Act to Extend the Maine Residents Property Tax Program to Persons Living in Subsidized Housing Who Receive Certain Disability Payments"

Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of that part designated "**Bureau of Revenue Services**" (page 1, lines 48 to 50 and page 2, lines 1 to 4 in amendment)


Further amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of the last 3 lines (page 2, lines 6 to 8 in amendment)

**FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment strikes the General Fund appropriation of \$20,000 in fiscal year 1999-00 to the Bureau of Revenue Services for the additional computer programming expenses required to implement the bill. The ability of the bureau to absorb these additional administrative expenses can not be determined at this time.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment deletes an appropriation to the Bureau of Revenue Services for computer programming expenses.
