	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §6162-A, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1997, c.
4	643, Pt. RR, §6, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

8	2. Income. Beginning November 1, 1999, the State Tax Assessor shall establish income limitations that are determined by reference to the nonfarm income official poverty line as
10	defined by the federal Office of Management and Budget and revised annually in accordance with the federal Omnibus Budget
12	Reconciliation Act of 1981, Section 673, Subsection 2.
14	Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §6162-A, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 528, §2, is repealed.
16	Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act takes effect November 1, 1999.
