COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 814, L.D. 1137, Bill, "An Act to Allow Police Officers to Prosecute Their Own Traffic Infractions in District Court"

Amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph M by striking out all of the last 3 lines (page 1, lines 25 to 27 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following: 'subsection 85, when representation in that matter has been approved by the prosecuting attorney'

SUMMARY

This amendment deletes language requiring that representation by a law enforcement officer be approved by the District Court Judge presiding at the trial. It also clarifies that representation by a law enforcement officer must be approved by the prosecuting attorney in each matter.
