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	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1762, sub-§2, ¶¶G and H are enacted to read:
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6	<u>G. The station, except for a fleet inspection station not engaged in retail work, must have legal and general</u>

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20	9. Inspection of station documents. After October 1, 1999,
20	an inspection station licensed pursuant to this section shall make available for inspection by the Chief of the State Police

26	This bill requires a motor vehicle inspection station,
28	except for a fleet inspection station not engaged in retail work,
	to have legal and general liability insurance and to have and
