30	This bill amends the apprentice program for new entrants
32	into Maine's lobster fishery by authorizing the Commissioner of Marine Resources to waive all or part of the practical lobster
	fishing experience component or the program length for a person
34	who is the child of a lobster and crab fishing license holder and who has obtained practical lobster fishing experience as an
36	unlicensed crew member assisting that license holder.
