 8 No funding to continue this initiative is currently included in Public Law 1999, chapter 16, the "current services" budget, or
 10 in the Governor's proposed supplemental "Part 2" budget.'

SUMMARY

16 The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the reference to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs 18 in the appropriation to the Education Research Institute and to clarify that the appropriated funds may not be used for travel. 20 The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
