
Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 8 in the first paragraph in the 6th line (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "problem" the following: 'if the governmental entity has made reasonable efforts to prevent or remedy the failure or malfunction'

SUMMARY

This amendment exempts a governmental entity from liability for failure or malfunction of a computer due to a Year 2000 problem if the entity has made a reasonable effort to prevent or remedy the problem.
