	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 34-A MRSA §1210-B is enacted to read:
6	§1210-B. Reimbursement to counties boarding prisoners from other jurisdictions
8	In addition to its duties pursuant to section 1210-A, the department shall reimburse in full a county for the county's
10	costs of boarding a prisoner from another jurisdiction in that county's jail. Reimbursement must cover costs incurred from the
12	day a prisoner arrives to the day the prisoner departs from the jail.

18	This bill requires the Department of Corrections to reimburse in full a county for the costs that county incurs
20	boarding a prisoner from another jurisdiction in its jail.
