2 4	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6722, as amended by PL 1983, c. 685, is further amended to read:
6	§6722. Closed areas
8	Unless-modified-by-regulation-adopted-under-section-6171-A, it is unlawful to fish for or take scallops in the coastal
10	waters from April 16th to October 31st, both days inclusive.
12	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6722-A is enacted to read:
14	§6722-A. Uniform openings
16	Notwithstanding section 6171-A, the commissioner may not by rule adjust the open scallop season.

22	This bill provides for a uniform open season for scallops along the entire coast of Maine.
