

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7457-A is enacted to read:

§7457-A. Taking of male or female deer; 1999 and 2000

Notwithstanding any rules adopted under section 7457, subsection 1, paragraph H that limit the taking of antlerless deer, a person may kill a male or female deer during the hunting seasons in calendar years 1999 and 2000. This section is repealed January 1, 2001.
