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#### \$241,040

The establishment of a higher weight category for truck registrations will increase Highway Fund revenue by \$241,040 in
fiscal year 2000-01 and by an annual amount of \$262,000 beginning in fiscal year 2001-02.

The bill includes a Highway Fund allocation of \$33,378 in fiscal year 2000-01 to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles within the Department of the Secretary of State for the costs of an additional Clerk Typist III position needed to administer the number of trucks registering in the new higher weight category. The estimated future costs are \$36,847 and \$37,001 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively.

The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system. This bill may also both increase and decrease the collection of fines.'

#### **SUMMARY**

26 This amendment is the minority report of the committee. It increases the axle weights allowed for single-, tandem- and tri-axle units. The amendment also removes a redundant provision of law. For vehicles found in excess of the limits set in this 30 bill, the fines are increased.
