COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 398, L.D. 1189, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Adequate Funding of Certain Public Safety Programs of Occupational or Professional Licensure Boards"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

This bill raises the licensing fee cap for three boards under the jurisdiction of the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Office of Licensing and Regulation, by \$15,720 in fiscal year 1999-00 and by \$85,820 in fiscal year 2000-01 and annually thereafter. The dedicated revenue increase for the Board of Complementary Health Care Providers is estimated to be \$36,100 annually beginning in fiscal year 2000-01. Dedicated revenue to the Board of Licensing of Dietetic Practice will increase by \$15,720 annually beginning in fiscal year 1999-00. The fee increases will increase the dedicated revenue of the Board of Licensure of Podiatric Medicine by \$34,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 2000-01.'
