2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §6207, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:**

6 **2-A. Determination of local or regional significance. At**
8 **least 10% of the funds distributed pursuant to this section must**
10 **be expended for acquisitions of lands that have local or regional**
12 **significance as determined by the board.**

14 **SUMMARY**

This bill requires that 10% of the funds expended by the Land for Maine's Future Board to acquire natural lands be used to acquire lands of local or regional significance.
