SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 409, L.D. 1198, Bill, "An Act to Expand Opportunities for Education, Training and Employment for Displaced Homemakers"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the 3rd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'2000-01'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the 7th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'All Other \$277,185'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$277,185 in fiscal year 1999-00 and by \$4,617 in fiscal year 2000-01.
