SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S.P. 409, L.D. 1198, Bill, "An Act to Expand Opportunities for Education, Training and Employment for Displaced Homemakers"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the 7th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'All Other \$80,000 \$80,000'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment decreases the General Fund cost of the bill by \$197,185 in fiscal year 1999-00 and by \$201,802 in fiscal year 2000-01.

SUMMARY

This amendment decreases the amounts appropriated for displaced homemakers to \$80,000 per fiscal year.
